An attractive metropolis



-  Developing an urban area where businesses, human resources and information come together to spur technological innovation
The urban functions in the Yumeshima/Sakishima area, the vicinity of Osaka Station and near Osaka Castle will be enhanced by utilizing the integrated special zone system, and efforts will be made to become a city with sophisticated functionality.
-  Urban redevelopment leveraging existing local assets
Existing public and private assets will be used effectively to revitalize the city. Typical examples are the revitalization of aging Senboku “New Town” and landscape conservation and development of urban communities leveraging local assets.
-  Becoming an urban community that plays a leading role in a low-carbon society
By promoting a system that utilizes CO₂ emissions reduction by businesses and the dissemination of electric and environmentally friendly-vehicles, the creation of an earth-friendly city will be promoted.
-  Becoming an environmentally friendly urban area
A city where residents can experience nature¹ will be created by planting trees and plants in urban areas and regenerating and conserving the natural environment in suburban areas, which are a major attraction of Osaka.
-  Creating an agricultural urban community – Rebuilding urban agriculture
The number of parties who are involved in agriculture, including companies and urban residents, will be increased in order to rebuild urban agriculture. Agriculture will be enhanced by developing new food businesses and promoting sales of agricultural products in Asia.



Agricultural, stock farms, forest products cultivated in Osaka, fish and seafood caught in Osaka Bay and landed at any port in Osaka Prefecture and processed foods recognized as specialties of Osaka.

¹ An initiative to increase the number of trees and amount of nature in Osaka and create a comfortable urban area where residents can feel the gifts of nature. It aims at increasing the ratio of residents who think Osaka is endowed with nature and who are in close contact with nature.
