Man: It depends on the effort you make.

- 2 Man: I've heard that you like that pianist.
Woman: Yes, she is a wonderful pianist. She is also doing various activities as a volunteer. I don't know how to express my respect for her.

Question: What does the woman mean?

- 3 Man: In my class, there are many different ideas about the song to sing at the music festival. So, we have not decided the song yet. I don't know what to do.
Woman: Well, you cannot solve that problem without talking more with your classmates.

Question: What does the woman mean?

- 4 Woman: Do you know the new restaurant that opened last month near the station?
Man: Yes. I've heard that the chicken curry at the restaurant is very delicious.
Woman: My sister says the restaurant serves various kinds of curry. Her favorite one is vegetable curry. My sister and I will go to the restaurant for lunch this weekend. Will you join us?
Man: Oh, really? Yes, I'll join you. Which curry should I have? It's hard to choose.
Woman: Well, it's difficult for me, too.

Question: What does the woman mean?

Man: I understand you, but I don't think I can get it. I just feel I am going to waste my time.

Stop reading. Now you are going to hear the conversation between Ben and Maki. They are talking about ways to get people's attention to sell things. You will hear their conversation and the question about it twice. When you are listening, you can write notes on the test paper about the things they say about ways to get people's attention to sell things. Now, listen to the conversation.

- Ben: Maki, did you read the passage about the two ways to get people's attention to sell something?
- Maki: Yes, I did, Ben. It is interesting.
- Ben: Actually, the two ways written in this passage are often used.
- Maki: For example?
- Ben: On TV, many things for cleaning houses are introduced. Some of them are introduced by telling that they are very useful and convenient to make houses clean. Other ones are shown together with famous actors or singers to produce nice images of the things. When you choose things to buy, which way is better?
- Maki: The second example you told me is Way B, and maybe Way B is better for me when I choose things to clean my house. I don't think there are big differences among the things to clean houses. So, I think producing nice images of the things is better to get my attention.
- Ben: I see. I think that showing a nice image of a thing in Way B is useful to make differences among things that don't actually have big differences.
- Maki: I think so, too.
- Ben: However, I think telling that something is very useful and convenient in Way A is better to get the attention of people who already have a clear purpose for using it.
- Maki: I see. Oh, I remembered my sister and brother talked about cars introduced on TV. You know that many kinds of cars are introduced in various ways on TV.
- Ben: Yes, there are many good examples.
- Maki: That's right. A car that has a special system to make the car safer is often introduced in Way A. This will get the attention of people who want to buy a safer car, like my sister. Another car is introduced together with a beautiful scene around the car. This is Way B. People who watch it may feel the cool life style of the driver. So, this way will be helpful to get the attention of people who want to live in a cool way, like my brother. Companies are always thinking about people who may buy their things.
- Ben: Yes. I think that the choice between Way A and Way B by companies depends on the people who will most probably buy their things.
- Maki: That's right. I think it is necessary to know how things are introduced on TV.

Question: What does Ben think about Way A and Way B? Explain his opinions in English.
