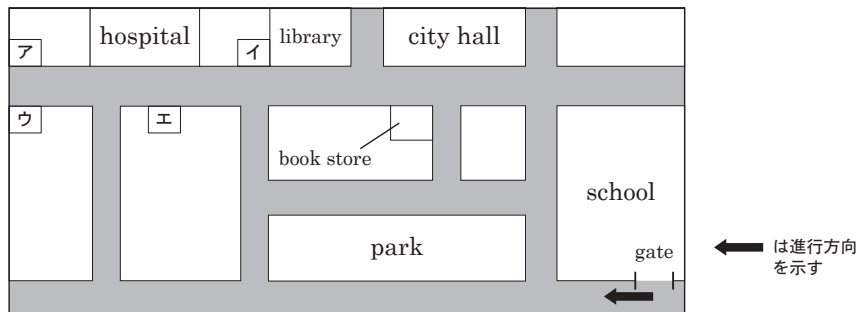

Kyoko: Oh, Mike. It's eight twenty-five now. What time did you wake up this morning?
Mike: I woke up just one hour ago.
- 3 George: Hi, Naomi. Will you go back home now?
Naomi: No. I am going to practice volleyball, George. Why?
George: I want to send this card to my family in America. Is there a post office near this school?
Naomi: Yes. I can tell you how to get there. Now we are at the gate of the school, right? So, go straight and turn right at the third corner.
George: OK.
Naomi: After that, go straight and you'll see a hospital in front of you. Then turn left and you'll find the post office on your right.
George: Thank you, Naomi. I'll go there.
- 4 Tom: Hi, Yoko. What will you do after school today?
Yoko: Hi, Tom. I will go shopping.
Tom: Do you have something to buy?
Yoko: Yes, I want to buy a birthday present for my brother. I am thinking about something for playing sports.
Tom: Oh, I see. I know you are a member of the volleyball club. Does your brother play volleyball, too?
Yoko: No. He has played baseball and basketball for some years, and he wants to start playing soccer. Oh, you play soccer, right? Can you go shopping with me?
Tom: OK. I will help you.
Yoko: Thank you very much. Let's meet at the station at 3:30.

- 5 Good afternoon, everyone. Today we will play a game in English. First, let's make groups of 4 students. I'll give each group a piece of paper. On the paper, write names of countries in the world, but the size of the countries should be larger than the size of Japan. There are small countries and large countries in the world. How about China? Is it smaller or larger than Japan? You know it is larger than Japan, right? How about Australia? Yes, it's a huge country. Well, there are a lot of big countries in the world. So, you can write many countries, but you cannot write the countries I have told you. In a group, try to find other countries and make a list of those countries. The group which writes more countries than all the other groups will win. Do you have any questions? Now, I'll give you 8 minutes.

Question 1: What should the students write on the paper?

Question 2: How many countries did Mr. Brown use as the examples of the answers?

- 6 Ms. White: Hi, Shota, you were not in my English class yesterday. What happened?
Shota: I'm sorry, Ms. White. I had a cold yesterday.
- Ms. White: Oh, are you OK now?
Shota: Yes, I'm fine now, thank you. Ms. White, what did I miss? Do we have homework?
- Ms. White: No. I didn't give any homework. But the students learned some important English expressions about numbers.
Shota: About numbers?
- Ms. White: Yes. They learned how to express big numbers over one thousand. For example, we say... one thousand, ten thousand, one hundred thousand. But, we don't say one thousand thousand. We say one million.
Shota: Wow, that sounds difficult.
- Ms. White: They are not difficult, but they are very important. So I will give students a test about them in the next lesson. You should ask your classmates and study for it.
Shota: OK, I will.
- Ms. White: You can come to see me any time if you have any questions. You are always welcome.
Shota: Thank you, Ms. White.
