What is night school?

1 Objective

The objective for night schools is to provide lower secondary education to people over age 15 (the maximum age limit for compulsory education in Japan) who had entered society without having received a sufficient junior high level education and wish to receive general education.

2 Eligibility for admission

A prospective student must meet all of the following admission criteria (1) to (3) for night school.

- (1) Over age 15 (the maximum age limit for compulsory education in Japan)
- (2) Did not graduate from junior high school or graduated from junior high school without receiving a substantially sufficient education.
- (3) Resides in Osaka Prefecture

Note: If you did not graduate from elementary school or do not live in Osaka Prefecture, please consult with your local board of education or a junior high school which offers a night school program.

3 Duration of study

The duration of study is 3 years.

4 School hours

Starting time: around 5 p.m.

Finish time: around 9 p.m.

(School hours may differ depending on the school.)
